The Mood and Anxiety Disorders Program (MAP), a vibrant clinical research program within the Department of Psychiatry at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, is seeking candidates for an Assistant Professor/Associate Professor position on the Academic Track. The Mount Sinai Department of Psychiatry is internationally acclaimed for excellence in scientific research, clinical care, and education. Applicants must have an MD or MD/PhD degree and have demonstrated excellent qualifications in clinical or translational research.

The successful applicant will have substantial experience in the design and conduct of clinical trials, experimental medicine studies, and/or neuroimaging or cognitive science studies in the area of depression or other mood and anxiety disorders. Investigators will work closely with other faculty members within MAP to lead multi-disciplinary, independent patient-oriented research designed to advance treatment discovery. Our program fosters synergy among faculty members through the sharing of ideas and resources in a team-oriented environment. Candidates will be encouraged to collaborate with faculty across Departments, and to utilize resources throughout the School of Medicine, including resources located within the Friedman Brain Institute, the Translational and Molecular Imaging Institute and the Brain Imaging Center.

The candidate must have excellent qualifications in research, and have demonstrated the potential to secure extramural grant funding. Candidates will have the opportunity to build an independent research program within a collegial and supportive academic environment.
