

Residency Program Director Faculty Position at University of California San Diego

The Department of Psychiatry at UCSD is recruiting academically oriented faculty to fulfill several priority areas in the growth of a department that is known for its excellence in research, education, and clinical care. It is our intention that one such faculty recruit will serve as Director of our Adult Psychiatry Residency Training Program. The Program Director position is a wonderful opportunity for a motivated academic-educator to oversee a well-established, fully-accredited training program. The program has filled each year with outstanding residents in general and research track adult psychiatry (combined N~40) and a psychiatry/family medicine combined training program (N~10). The Department of Psychiatry also houses several psychiatry fellowships (e.g., child, geriatric, community, addiction, psychosomatic and research) and a talented, dedicated group of faculty teachers. The position will offer the opportunity to implement innovative ideas for training, curriculum development, scholarship, and collaboration with our clinical partners. Full departmental and institutional support for administration, supervision, research, and faculty and program development will be included.

Applicants for the Program Director position should be ABPN Certified in general psychiatry, and have substantial faculty experience in an ACGME-accredited training program and be able to obtain an unrestricted California medical license. Demonstration of outstanding academic accomplishments and trajectory, which may include basic or clinical research, innovative educational program development and teaching excellence, and clinical leadership is required. A candidate is expected to devote at least 50% of their time to Residency Director activities and will need to qualify for one of the academic appointments at the Associate or Full Professor level as posted in UCSD position announcement <https://apolrecruit.ucsd.edu/apply/JPF00696>.
