



MEDICAL DIRECTOR, AUTISM PROGRAM AT RUSH UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER – PSYCHIATRY

The Department of Psychiatry at Rush University Medical Center in Chicago is recruiting a Medical Director for our growing clinical and research program in autism spectrum disorder (ASD). We are seeking a Board Certified adult/child and adolescent psychiatrist with a background and expertise in autism, both clinical and research. The Medical Director will oversee the clinical and research programs of the autism center and will serve as liaison to the hospital and medical school. This position will include public speaking, teaching and assisting in marketing the program. Candidates should have a national reputation in autism, collaborations with other clinicians and researchers, proven commitment to training residents and students, and an established record of leadership. Qualified applicants will be eligible for faculty appointment at the Associate Professor or above level.
