The Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center (BIDMC) Department of Psychiatry is seeking a full-time faculty member with M.D., Ph.D. or M.D./Ph.D. and a strong record of research accomplishment related to clinical neuroscience and public sector psychiatry. The successful candidate will play a leadership role in the BIDMC Division of Public Psychiatry at the Massachusetts Mental Health Center (MMHC). With anticipated appointment at the Associate Professor level, the candidate should have a successful record of federally-funded patient-oriented research and substantial experience in mentoring trainees in research and clinical settings. The position will be affiliated with an extensive psychosis research program, and research experience with serious mental disorders such as schizophrenia, major depression and bipolar disorder is advantageous. Research areas of current interest include neurocognition; biological markers; neuropsychopharmacology; evidence-based psychotherapy; collaborative care systems; and implementation science. Candidates who have completed clinical training in psychiatry or psychology are encouraged to apply. The candidate is expected to maintain external research funding and to build collaborations with faculty members at BIDMC and the broader Harvard Medical School (HMS) research community.

The Department of Psychiatry is a major teaching site for HMS and both the Harvard Longwood and BIDMC Psychiatry Residency Training Programs. The position will include opportunities for teaching medical students, post-doctoral fellows and other trainees.
