

## **Assistant/Associate Professor Faculty Position in the Psychotic Disorders Division**

McLean Hospital, Psychotic Disorders Division, and the Department of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School, invite applications for faculty positions at the Assistant or Associate Professor level from qualified individuals with clinical/translational research interests relevant to schizophrenia or bipolar disorder. The Division embraces a multi-disciplinary approach to improve our understanding of the neurobiological factors associated with psychotic disorders across multiple levels of analyses (e.g., gene, brain, behavior) across the lifespan, and to explore novel interventions to relieve the suffering of individuals with psychotic disorders. We seek investigators to complement our existing research programs. Priority areas include, but are not limited to: clinical impact and neurobiology of treatment interventions, early interventions to alter the trajectory of psychotic disorders, and focus on adverse outcomes associated with illness itself or treatments (such as metabolic syndrome).

Opportunities exist for developing strong collaborations within McLean Hospital and across Harvard Medical School as well as other local institutions. McLean has over a 100-year history of supporting clinical research in association with Harvard Medical School. Depending on the research focus, candidates will have access to research-dedicated human (3 T, 4 T) and animal (9.4 T) MRI scanners within the McLean Imaging Center, as well as thriving clinical services for the care of patients with psychotic disorders, including a first episode clinic. In addition, there are associated laboratories for neurobiology and genetics.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. and/or M.D. or professional doctorate, appropriate postdoctoral experience, and a record of extramural funding and publications demonstrating expertise and productivity. Depending upon qualifications, applicants must either meet the academic criteria for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. The position offers clinical research space, affiliation with a large clinical and basic neuroscience research program and research infrastructure support. The successful candidate will be expected to develop a competitive, independent, and largely externally funded research program and to collaborate with existing McLean investigators. Salary and recruitment packages will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Qualified women and minority candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.
