T32 Postdoctoral Scholar Positions in 2023

Despite decades of major advances in the ability to study the brain processes that control behavior, we have not yet reached the goal of translating this new knowledge into breakthroughs for psychiatric illness. Progress has been limited by the fact that few researchers have a combined understanding of psychiatric illness as it appears in humans and how it is studied in laboratory models, which limits effective communication across disciplines and translation of discoveries into treatments. This McLean Hospital training program, which is generously sponsored by the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH), is designed to ensure that postdoctoral trainees develop a sophisticated understanding of both psychiatry and neuroscience by utilizing specialized mentorship teams with expertise that covers both disciplines, thereby hastening the development of new treatments.

POSITIONS AVAILABLE: Limited 1 to 3-year scholarships (fellowships) are available for postdoctoral trainees at experience levels ranging from 0-7 years.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS: M.D, Ph.D., or M.D.-Ph.D. is required.

CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS: US citizens or permanent residents (documentation required).

SALARY: The base salary for these positions is aligned with NIH guidelines for experience (<https://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/notice-files/NOT-OD-22-132.html>).
