

2024 Travel Award Nominations/Supporting Letter Instructions

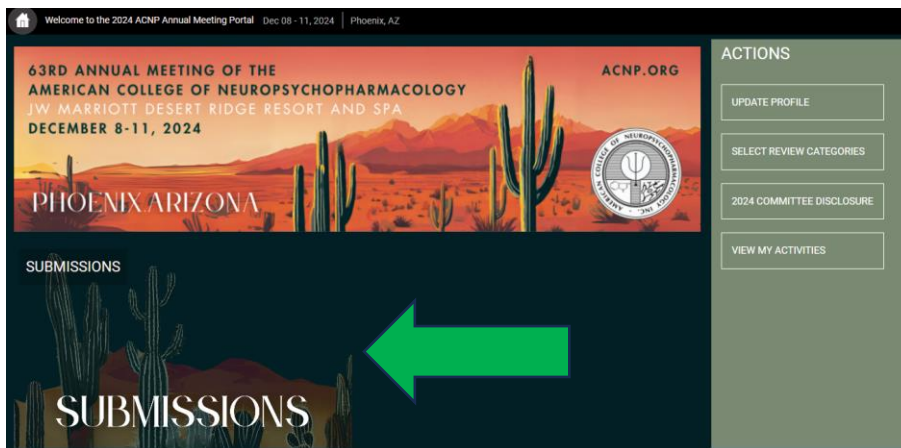
Once the Travel Award Applicant has entered their application and selected the nominator, you will receive an email prompting you to complete the supporting letter. If you do not receive the email, follow the instructions listed below.

Members will have to enter the supporting letter into a text field in the submission system, which will be kept confidential from the travel award applicant. The letter should include a concise and compelling description of why the candidate should receive the award. Focus on the candidate's research accomplishment and how and why at this time in their development this award would advance their career. Indicate whether the candidate is in the: top 1%, top 5%, top 10%, top 25%, or top 50% of all active research junior colleagues (M.D., D.O., D.V.M., D.N.P., Psy.D., Ph.D., or Pharm.D.) the ACNP member has known.

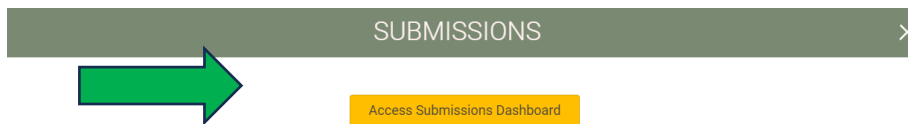
