Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Psychosis Clinical Research

McLean Hospital is offering a postdoctoral fellowship opportunity in psychotic disorders research.

We are seeking individuals who have already completed all requirements for PhD, MD, or other relevant doctoral degree in psychiatry, clinical research, or other related fields. This position is supported by Departmental Funds. Fellows will be employed for an initial period of up to two years; this may be extended in discussion with the supervisor depending on progress of the fellow and research projects.

The fellow will join ongoing projects examining the impact of metabolic and bioenergetic interventions on the brain and clinical outcomes in disorders including schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. The fellow will also obtain training on clinical research, including regulatory aspects, patient interactions, and data collection and interpretation. The fellowship provides experience in a well-funded research environment with excellent opportunities for faculty collaboration and publication.
