An early career scientist is defined as an individual who is at or below Assistant Professor (or equivalent level if in a non-academic institution) AND in a research-intensive training position, i.e.: non-clinician Ph.D. students, medical residents or fellows, Pharm.D. residents, interns, and post-doctoral fellows. The applicant must be current working outside the U.S.
